

## How to Use YouTube Studio Blur Tool

The **YouTube Studio Blur Tool** allows you to **blur faces, objects, or sensitive content AFTER** a video has been uploaded. This is useful for **quick compliance fixes** without needing to re-edit and re-upload your video.

## Why Use YouTube's Blur Tool?

## How to Blur Objects in YouTube Studio

### 1 Open YouTube Studio Editor

- 4 Click **“Editor”** in the left menu.

### 3 Apply Face Blur (Automatic Detection)

#### ✓ Steps:

- 1 Select **“Face Blur”** and wait for YouTube to detect faces.
- 2 Click on the detected face(s) you want to blur.
- 3 YouTube will automatically track and blur the face throughout the video.

 **Pro Tip: Great for hiding people's identities but limited for complex blurring needs.**

### 4 Save & Apply the Blur Effect

### ✔ Steps:

- 1 Click **“Save”** to apply the blur.
- 2 YouTube will process the changes (can take several hours).
- 3 Once complete, the blurred version replaces the original—**no re-upload needed!**
